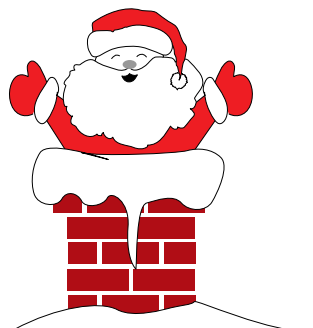

Thoughts from the President

I want to begin by thanking all of you for your support of the club! We are very fortunate to have a first class facility. We've continued to have more weddings this fall and bookings for events through December are well above last year!

Financially the club is doing well after quite a few very difficult years. The addition last year of 55 members and the Cap Ex fund has helped us to make much-needed repairs and improvements to the club. The kitchen project is complete!

In the project was a new freezer door, heat lamps, steam table, chargrill, slicer, 2 new ranges, convection ovens, microwaves, carving lamps, and food carts. Also included were pans, banquet plates, new lighting and a rework of the electrical system to accommodate the new equipment and update breaker boxes. It's amazing Joe could keep the service at the level he has with such an inferior situation. On top of this, the ice machine broke during the member-guest and has been patched together until it could be replaced. We now have a new one at the cost of \$10,000. A major improvement was purchasing one that has the compressor on the roof, eliminating a tremendous amount of heat in the kitchen.

Keep in mind that without the Cap Ex fund, a bill like this would have been a huge burdern to the club financially. Thanks to all of you who have participated. To date, we have had 20% of the membership contribute. The key is the support we get between now and the end of next year. We have an opportunity to hit our goal if the remaining 80% of the membership participates!

After the kitchen, there are some minor projects but the major one left is the clubhouse. This encompasses the interior and the exterior. This is a major expense that involves replacing rotten exterior doors, windows and a fresh painting. To bill to do this correctly is \$300,000. Currently we don't have the funds to do this project.

I would be remiss in not mentioning the golf course. Comments have been extremely positive. The best, which came from a couple of our long-term members, "I can't remember the golf course ever looking this nice." Under Gus' leadership and the hard work of R.E. Turner and his staff, we truly have a championship-conditioned course!!

I wish all of you a fun fall season; enjoy the celebration of our 60th anniversary, have a Happy Thanksgiving and a Merry Christmas!

Tennis



The arrival of November marks the beginning of another indoor tennis season. Having our indoor tennis center is a huge bonus to the membership. We hope everyone can come out and make great use of it this winter. If you are still interested in contract time, you can check with us about available time slots. Space is available. If you do not have contract time, feel free to come out and play; the cost to play is \$5.00 per person per hour. Guest fee for non-members would be additional \$10.00 to the court fee.

One of the consistent questions we get is about footwear. All we ask is that you wear non-marking shoes. Most shoes are this way. The way to test your shoes is to take the side of your sole and pull it against the court surface. If the shoes leave a black mark then a different pair of shoes is needed to play. If they leave a white streak they are fine. Second some players are concerned about their shoes gripping too much. This is a personal feel for each player but if you feel your shoes have too much grip a older pair of shoes may work better till the new pair wear down a little.

Indoor Contract time will begin on Monday November 5th and continue until Sunday May 5th. All members of the group will be billed in October. If a guest plays for a member that is in a contract group there is a guest fee that is due for the guest. Guest fee is \$10.00. We appreciate your help with this by having the guest sign in with us.

As always we hope to keep the outdoor courts open as long as possible. This has been affected by the hurricane that blew through the middle of October. The middle fence of the outdoor courts was blown down and has closed 4 of the outdoor courts. The process of repair has begun and you can check in the pro shop for updates. As the weather turns colder this is what will affect the playability of the courts. As the temperature drops below freezing the outdoor courts will freeze and thaw which will soften them. If you are unsure of the outdoor court conditions please check in the pro shop.
